- 1945-51 Student at the Academy of Fine Arts in Vienna  
Foundation of the "Vienna School of Fantastic Realism" together with Fuchs, Hausner, Hutter and Lehmden
- 1947-51 vocal studies at the music school of the city of Vienna
- 1951-54 Extensive travelling by bicycle through Europe and Africa
- 1954-55 Lives as a singer and dancer in Israel
- 1956 Performed as a dancer at the Raimundtheater in Vienna
- 1957 Marries the Israeli Naomi
- 1957-63 Resident in Paris
